

Steps for adding your Xerox printer on all Windows system:

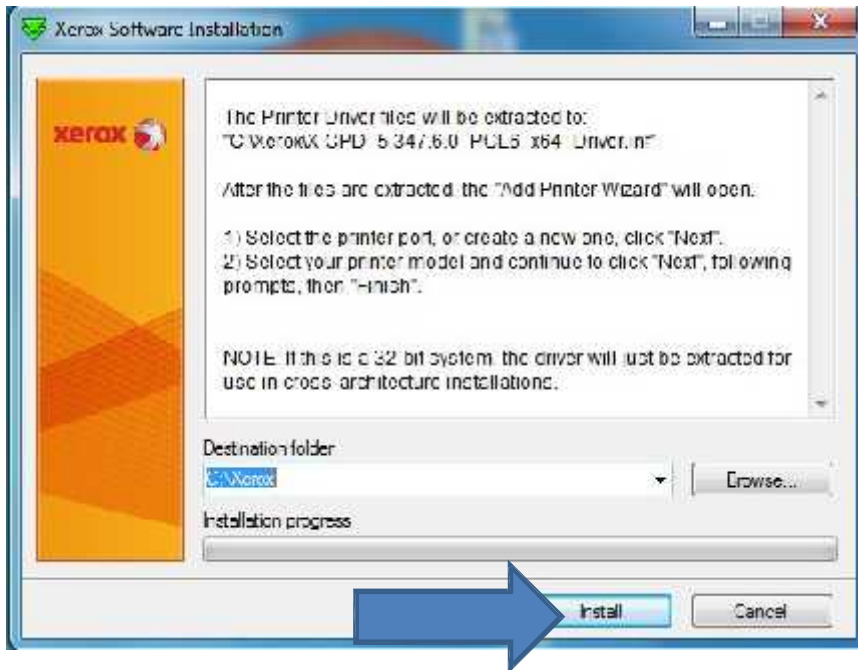
1. After downloading your driver, double-click on the driver and then click on “Run”.



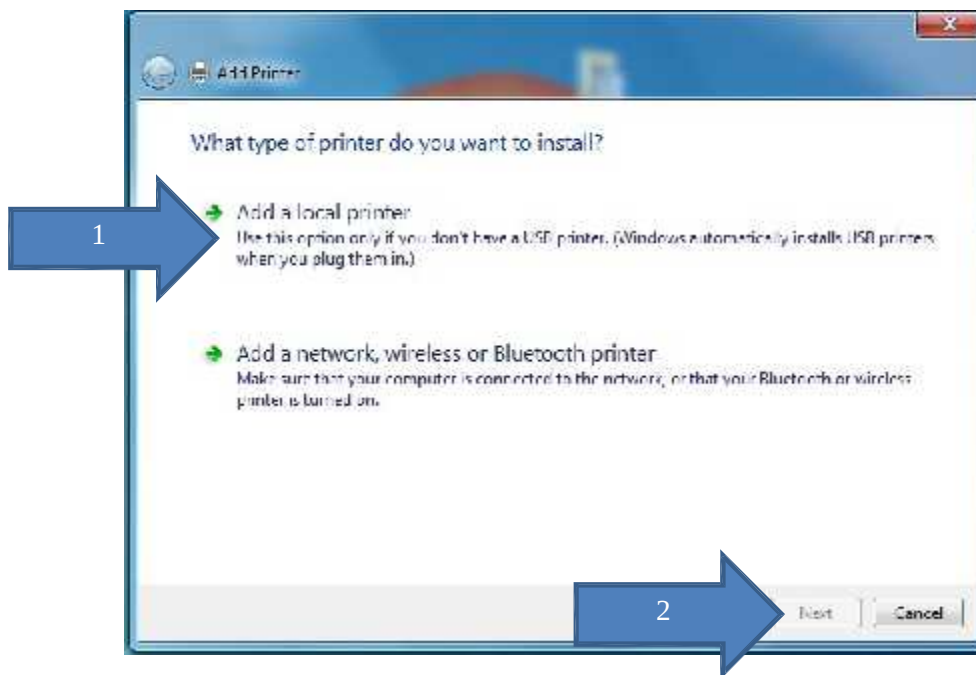
2. On the License Agreement window, click on “Accept”.



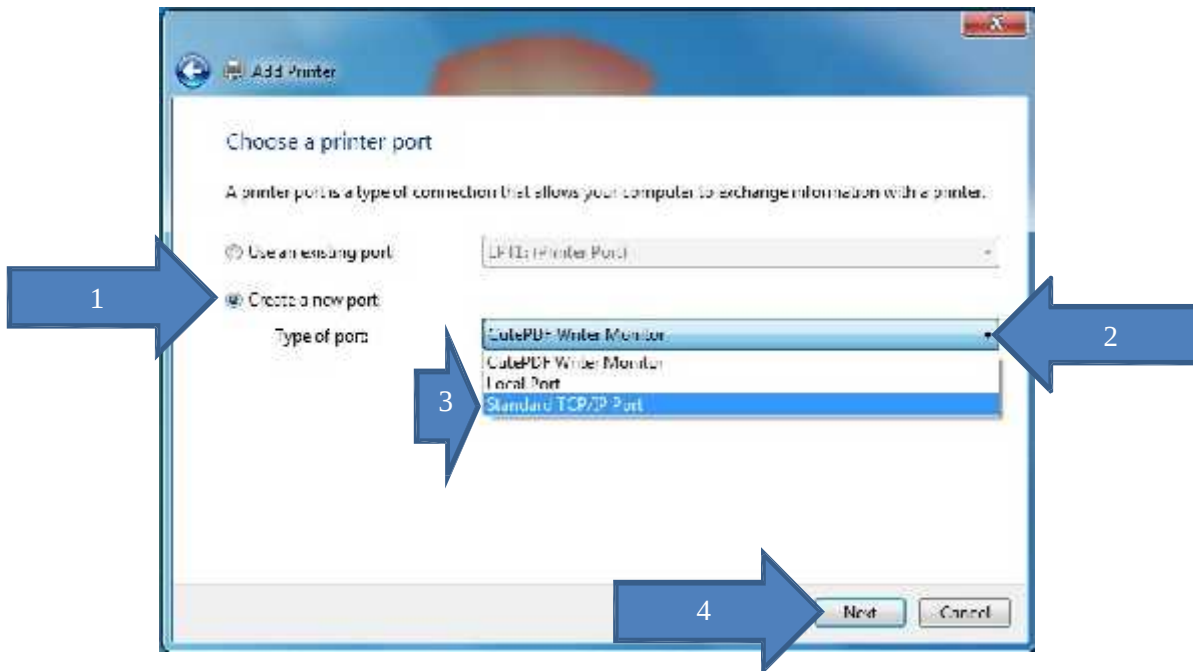
3. On the Xerox Software Installation window, click on “Install”.



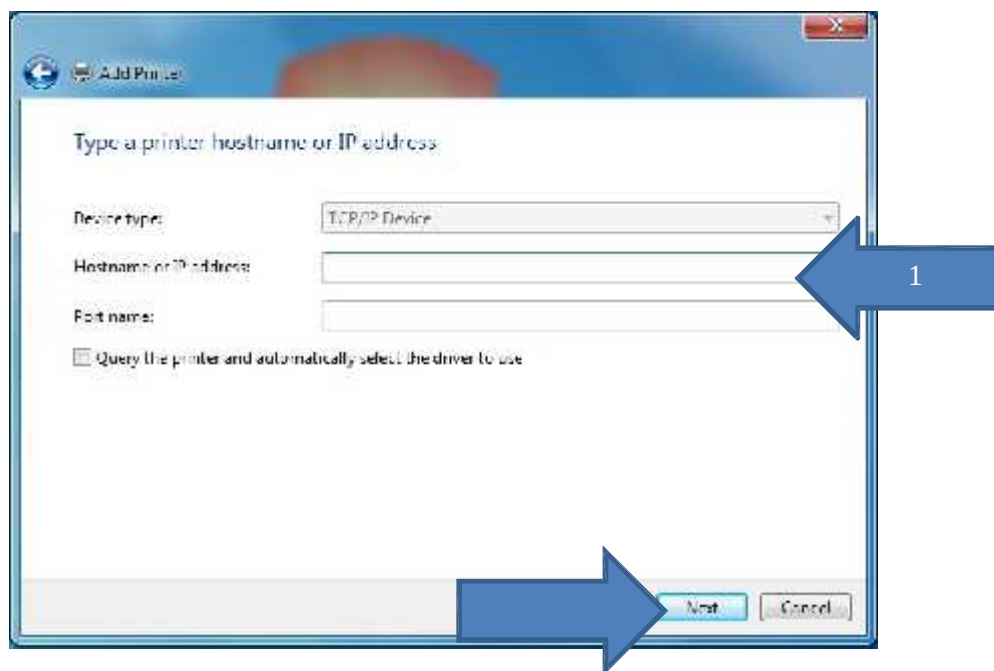
4. On the What type of printer do you want to install window, click on “Add a local printer” option and then click on “Next”.



- On the Choose a printer port window, click on “Create a new port:” and on “Type of port:” click on the drop-down arrow and select “Standard TCP/IP Port”. And then click on “Next”.

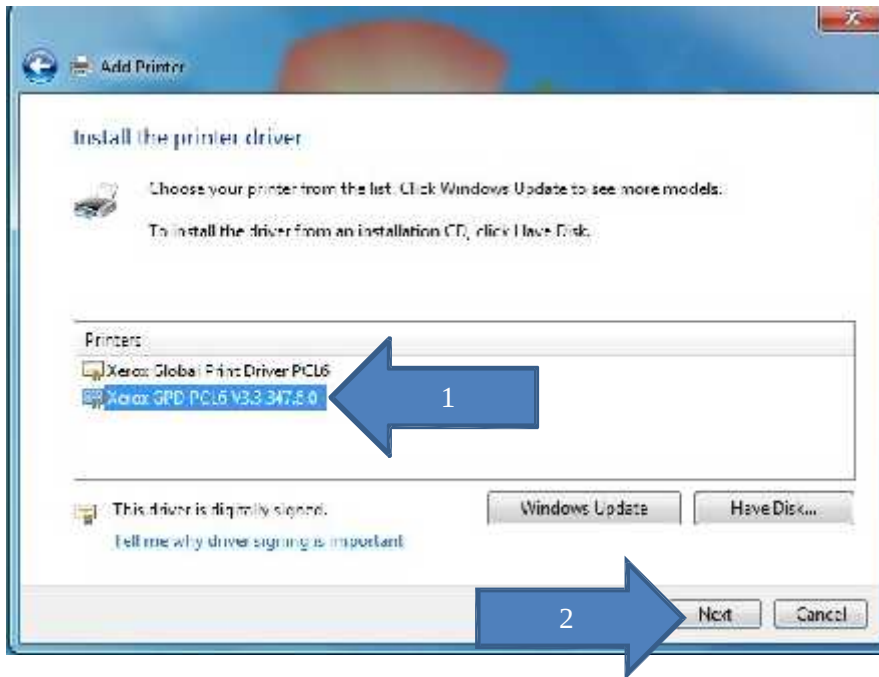


- On the Type a printer hostname or IP address window, input the IP address of the printer you are going to use on the “Hostname or IP address” field. And then click on “Next”.

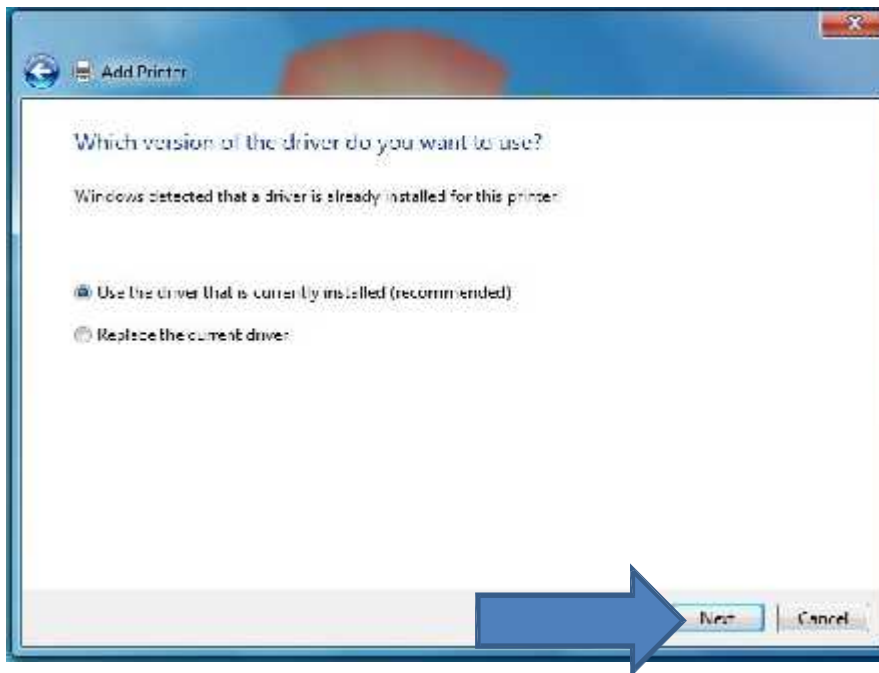

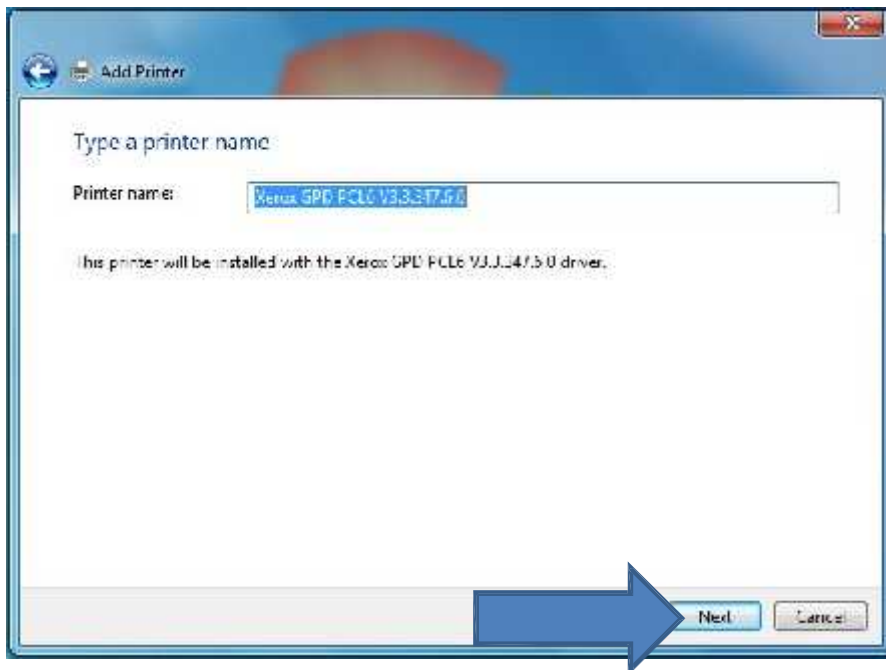
7. On the Install the printer driver window, select “Xerox GPD PCL6 V3.3.347.6.0” and then click on “Next”.



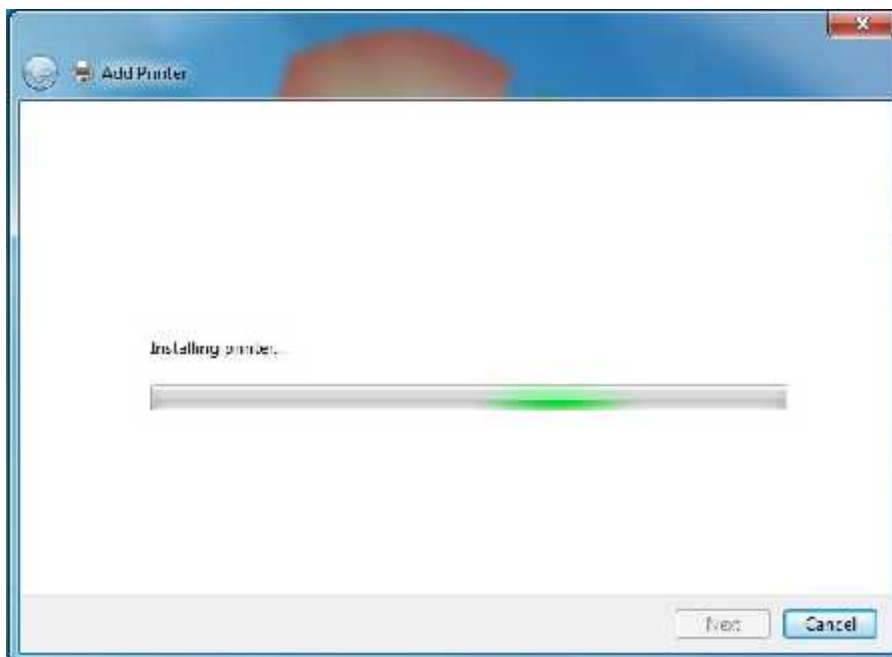
8. On the Which version of the driver do you want to use window, click on “Next”.



9. On the Type a printer name window, click on “Next”.



10. Wait for a few seconds while Windows installs your printer driver.



11. On the Printer Sharing window, click on “Next”.
