

Access Lesson 03 – Zillow Properties

Problem: The **Properties** database contains records of Agents and Houses of a realty company.

1. Open your **Access Lesson 03** folder. Rename the **Properties** database file as follows:

Zillow Properties (followed by your initials)

2. Open the **Agents** table in Datasheet View. Look at the table to familiarize yourself with the data. Look at the 6 Fields (Agent ID, First Name, Last Name, Affiliation, Office Phone, Cell Phone)
3. Open the **Houses** table in Datasheet View. Look at the table to familiarize yourself with the data. Look at the 10 Fields (Listing ID, Address, Bedrooms, Bathrooms, Garages, Living Areas, Exterior, Date Listed, Price, Agent ID)
4. Using the Create Tab, **CREATE** the 3 queries using **Query Design** view with the following search criteria. (**HINT: You have to look at the Table to view what you are searching for.*)

Query	Add Table	Add Fields	Search Criteria	Save As
Query 1	Agents	First Name, Last Name, Affiliation, Cell Phone	Only the agents that work for Montglow Real Estate	Montglow Agents – FirstName LastName
Query2	Houses	Address, Bedrooms, Bathrooms, Price	2 or more bedrooms and 2 or more bathrooms	Buyer1 – FirstName LastName
Query3	Houses	Address, Bedrooms, Bathrooms, Price	Budget of no more than \$100,000	Buyer2 – FirstName LastName

5. Save each query, and then close it.
6. Close the database.
