Access Lesson 03 – Zillow Properties

Problem: The **Properties** database contains records of Agents and Houses of a realty company.

1. Open your **Access Lesson 03** folder. Rename the **Properties** database file as follows:

- 2. Open the **Agents** table in Datasheet View. Look at the table to familiarize yourself with the data. Look at the 6 Fields (Agent ID, First Name, Last Name, Affiliation, Office Phone, Cell Phone)
- 3. Open the **Houses** table in Datasheet View. Look at the table to familiarize yourself with the data. Look at the 10 Fields (Listing ID, Address, Bedrooms, Bathrooms, Garages, Living Areas, Exterior, Date Listed, Price, Agent ID)
- 4. Using the Create Tab, **CREATE** the 3 queries using **Query Design** view with the following search criteria. (*HINT: You have to look at the Table to view what you are searching for.)
