## PowerPoint Assessment - Swimming

## Perform the following tasks:

- 1. Open the **Swimming** PowerPoint file you downloaded.
- 2. Save as: **Swimming Final (followed by your initials)**.
- 3. Refer to diagram on the Course Web Page for the final solution.
- 4. On Slide 1,
  - a. Change the Slide theme to a theme with a black background. Apply only to Slide 1 (right-click on the Theme of your choice), all other slides remain the same.
  - b. Change the title text font to Britannic Bold.
  - c. Increase the font size to 48 point.
  - d. Change the font color to Yellow, and then center the text.
  - e. Change the font case to UPPERCASE.
  - f. Move the title text placeholder to the top of the slide. Delete the subtitle text placeholder.
  - g. Insert your name using a Text Box. Position it towards the bottom of the slide.
  - h. Save.
- 5. On Slide 1,
  - a. Apply the Moderate Frame, White picture style to the picture.
  - b. Move the picture to the center of the slide.
- 6. On Slide 1,
  - a. Apply the Grow/Shrink Emphasis animation effect to the Teardrop shape.
  - b. Change the duration to 03.00 seconds. Change the Start timing setting to After Previous.
  - c. Save.
- 7. On Slide 2,
  - a. Change the title text font to Franklin Gothic Heavy.
  - b. Increase the font size to 40 point.
  - c. Change the font color to Dark Blue and then center the text.
- 8. Use the Format Painter to apply these same attributes to the title text font on Slide 4.
- 9. On Slide 2,
  - a. Apply the Bevel Perspective picture style to the picture.
  - b. Increase the size of the picture to approximately 5.01" height and then position it on the right side of the slide.
  - c. Save.
- 10. On Slide 2,
  - a. Apply the Zoom Entrance animation effect to the bulleted list.
  - b. Change the duration to 02.00 seconds, and then change the Start timing setting to After Previous.

- c. Save.
- 11. On Slide 3,
  - a. Insert the video file called Swim.
  - b. Increase the size of the video to approximately 5.00" height and move the video to the center of the slide.
  - c. Apply the Simple Frame, White video style to the video.
  - d. Change the Video Border color to Yellow.
  - e. Trim the video so that the End Time is 00:14:151.
  - f. Play the video until around the two-second mark, set the Poster Frame to the Current Frame.
  - g. Start the video automatically.
  - h. Save.
- 12. On Slide 3,
  - a. Insert a text box on the left side of the slide and type **Video highlights from one of our swim meets** in the text box.
  - b. Change the font to Arial, change font size to 24 point, and then bold and italicize this text.
- 13. On Slide 4,
  - a. Increase the size of the swimmer picture to approximately 3.88" height.
  - b. Apply the Beveled Oval, Black picture style to the picture.
  - c. Change the border color to Light Green and then change the border weight to 6 pt.
  - d. Position the picture on the left side of the slide under the title.
  - e. Save.
- 14. On Slide 4,
  - a. Apply the Float Out exit animation effect to the flippers illustration.
  - b. Change the duration to 05.00 seconds. Change the Start timing setting to After Previous.
- 15. **Create a Closing Slide** similar to the Title Slide.
  - a. The closing slide should signal to your audience that the presentation has drawn to a close. (Do not type "The End")
- 16. Apply an appropriate transition to all slides.
- 17. Compress all pictures for E-mail (96 ppi). Same procedure you did for your **Bees Final**.
- 18. Compress Media (Low Quality) for E-mail.
  - a. On the Ribbon, click the File tab.
  - b. Click Compress Media
  - c. Click Low Quality.
- 19. Save the presentation.
