

## How to Insert a YouTube video into PowerPoint.

\*This option requires you to have an Internet connection.

- 1) Go to YouTube and **Copy** the URL of the video you would like to use in your PowerPoint.
- 2) Open your PowerPoint file and go to the slide that you want to put your video.
- 3) Click the Office Button.
- 4) Click the PowerPoint Options button.
- 5) Check the box next to Show Developer tab in the Ribbon. Click OK.
- 6) A new Developer tab has been added to the Ribbon. Click the Developer Tab on the Ribbon. In the Controls group, click the More Controls button (Hammer/Wrench).
- 7) Scroll down and select **Shockwave Flash Object**. Click OK.
- 8) On the slide, draw a box to contain your video.
- 9) Click on the Properties button on the Ribbon.
- 10) Navigate to the **Movie** property, Paste the URL in the text box to the right of Movie.
- 11) In the URL, delete **watch?**
- 12) In the URL, delete = and replace with /
  - a. Original: <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=x3KDmqyFFil>
  - b. New URL: <http://www.youtube.com/v/x3KDmqyFFil>
- 13) Close the Properties dialog box.
- 14) Save your file.
- 15) Run your Slide Show to test the video.
- 16) You can also use YouTube and watch several videos on to Insert a YouTube video into PowerPoint.
