INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Create a **CSS Travel** folder in your CS211 Shared Folder.
 - HTML file save as: **index.html**
 - External CSS file save as: **style.css**
 - Create an **images** sub folder. Place all images used in your project in the sub folder.
2. Create a **TRAVEL** webpage enticing viewers to visit an exotic locale.
 - Include Images of What They Will See,
 - Lists of Things To See and Places To Go
 - and Paragraphs of enticing details.
3. Page Layout:
 - Use html layout tags:
`<header>, <nav>, <section>, <article>, <aside> <footer>`
****OR****
 - One of the CSS Layout Templates using `<div>` tags to style different parts of your content.
4. Use ****EXTERNAL CSS**** to style your web page.
5. In the header:
 - Use an image or textured background for your header to entice viewers to your web page.
6. For the Main Content:
 - Use **two or more columns** for your layout.
7. Links
 - At least **3 links** that opens in another window.
8. In the footer:
 - Put a copyright notice: ©[year] [name].
