

JavaScript Arrays

Storing Data in Arrays

JavaScript arrays are used to store **multiple values (strings, numbers, booleans, etc.)** in a **single variable**.

Empty Array

```
var cars = [ ];
```

Creating an Array

```
var cars = ["Saab", "Volvo", "BMW"];
```

3 Variables – Longer Method

```
var car1 = "Saab";
var car2 = "Volvo";
var car3 = "BMW";
```

Array [Index (position)] – Begins at [0]

```
var cars = ["Saab", "Volvo", "BMW"];
```

*NOTE
[0] is the first index

	0	1	2
cars	cars[0]	cars[1]	cars[2]
	Saab	Volvo	BMW

Array [Index (position)] – Last [Index]

**IMPORTANT

arrayname[arrayname.length-1] is also another way to access the last index.

```
var cars = ["Saab", "Volvo", "BMW"];
```

	0	1	2
cars	cars[0]	cars[1]	cars[2]
	Saab	Volvo	BMW

```
<p id="demo"></p>
```

What is output?

```
<script>
```

```
var cars = ["Saab", "Volvo", "BMW"];
```

```
document.getElementById("demo").innerHTML = cars;
```

```
</script>
```

Declaring and Initializing Arrays Syntax ****Preferred Method**

1) Creates an Array, and 2) assigns values to it

```
var array_name = [item1, item2, ...];
```

```
var cars = ["Saab", "Volvo", "BMW"];
```

Declaring and Initializing Arrays Syntax – **Spanning several lines**

Creates an Array, and assigns values to it

```
var cars = [  
    "Saab",  
    "Volvo",  
    "BMW"  
];
```

ACCESSING Elements of an Array

```
<script>
```

```
var cars = ["Saab", "Volvo", "BMW"];
```

	0	1	2
cars	cars[0]	cars[1]	cars[2]
	Saab	Volvo	BMW

```
var name = cars[0];
```

```
document.getElementById("demo").innerHTML = name;
```

```
</script>
```

ACCESSING Elements of an Array at the END

```
<script>
```

```
var cars = ["Saab", "Volvo", "BMW"];
```

```
document.getElementById("demo").innerHTML = cars[cars.length -1];
```

```
</script>
```

	0	1	2
cars	cars[0]	cars[1]	cars[2]
	Saab	Volvo	BMW

What is the output?

CHANGING Elements of an Array – use = operator

Refer to their index number.

	0	1	2
cars	cars[0]	cars[1]	cars[2]
	Saab	Volvo	BMW

cars[0] = "Opel";

`document.getElementById("demo").innerHTML = cars[0];`

DISPLAYING the entire Array

```
<script>
```

	0	1	2
cars	cars[0]	cars[1]	cars[2]
	Saab	Volvo	BMW

```
var cars = ["Saab", "Volvo", "BMW"];
```

```
document.getElementById("demo").innerHTML = cars;
```

```
</script>
```
