- 4. Add a div element with the following content **This is a div element**. Give your div element an id "mdiv"
- 5. Use a **<button>** tag for each of the following:
 - a. Find an HTML element (with id="mhead") and change the element content (innerHTML) to "Welcome to JavaScript".
 - b. Find an HTML element (with id="mpara") and change the element content (innerHTML) to "JavaScript Introduction".
 - c. Find an HTML element (with id="mdiv") and change the element content (innerHTML) to "How To?".
