- 7. Create a function called **cityLocation()**. Pass the city into the cityLocation function.
- 8. The function will return the State of the city entered.
 - a. Use **switch statements** that will return the city's **state** based on the city entered at the prompt. (At least 5 cities/states options).
 - b. Include a default option.
- 9. Display the following in a HTML element with id selector "state":
