 - a. Declare 2 variables **exam1** and **exam2** and assign an exam score to each variable.
5. Create a function called **examAvg**(Pass in **exam1** and **exam2** as parameters).
6. In the function:
 - a. Calculate the **average of exam1 and exam2**
 - b. **return** your answer.
7. Call your function in a **document.getElementById("avg").innerHTML =**
