INSTRUCTIONS: - Read the statements below and perform the tasks.

1. Create a HTML document, save as: **functiontotalbill.html**
2. Add a heading element **Calculate Total Bill**.
3. Add a paragraph element **<p id="tip"></p>**.
4. Write a **<script>** to:
 - a. Declare 2 variables **totalBill** and **tipVal** and assign a number to each variable.
5. Create a function called **calcTotalBill**(Pass in **totalBill** and **tipVal** as parameters).
6. In the function:
 - a. Declare a variable **tipAmt** and calculate **the Tip Amount by multiplying the totalBill to the tipVal**.
 - b. Calculate **the Total Amount Due by adding the totalBill to the tipAmt**.
 - c. **return** your answer.
7. Call your function in a **document.getElementById("tip").innerHTML =**
