Using parseInt

***Example to display a picture in the document.getElementById**

Search the Internet for 3 free Pictures

first
second
equal



Use the picture in a document.getElementById

```
document.getElementById("myImg").src = "filename";
```

EXAMPLE:

```
document.getElementById("myImg").src = "first.jpg";
```

```
<h1>Find Larger Number</h1>
<button onclick="twoNums()">Find Larger Number</button>
<p id="text"></p>
<img id="myImg">
<script>
function twoNums()
{
    var num1 = parseInt(prompt("Enter a Integer Number"));
    var num2 = parseInt(prompt("Enter a Integer Number"));

    if (num1 > num2)
    {
        document.getElementById("text").innerHTML = "First number is greater than second number";
        document.getElementById("myImg").src = "first.jpg";
    }
    else if (num2 > num1)
    {
        document.getElementById("text").innerHTML = "Second number is greater than first number";
        document.getElementById("myImg").src = "second.jpg";
    }

    else
    {
        document.getElementById("text").innerHTML = "Both numbers are equal";
        document.getElementById("myImg").src = "equal.jpg";
    }
}
</script>
```
