

In- Class Exercise – JS Output (innerHTML)

INSTRUCTIONS: - Read the statements below and perform the tasks.

1. Create a HTML document, save as: **JSOutput_inner.html**
2. Add a header element with the following content **Welcome to CS211**. Give your header element an id **"mH"**
3. Add a paragraph element with the following content **This is a p element**. Give your p element an id **"mP"**
4. Add a div element with the following content **This is a div element**. Give your div element an id **"mDIV"**
5. Use a **<button>** tag for each of the following:
 - a. Find an HTML element (with **id="mH"**) and change the element content (**innerHTML**) to **"Welcome to JavaScript"**.
 - b. Find an HTML element (with **id="mP"**) and change the element content (**innerHTML**) to **"JavaScript Introduction"**.
 - c. Find an HTML element (with **id="mDIV"**) and change the element content (**innerHTML**) to **"How To?"**.

Example:

<button type="button" onclick="document.getElementById("give it an id").innerHTML = "Enter Text to Change Here"">Click Me!</button>
```
