- 5. Use a **<button>** tag for each of the following:
 - a. Find an HTML element (with id="mH") and change the element content (innerHTML) to "Welcome to JavaScript".
 - b. Find an HTML element (with id="mP") and change the element content (innerHTML) to "JavaScript Introduction".
 - c. Find an HTML element (with id="mDIV") and change the element content (innerHTML) to "How To?".
