

# JavaScript Variable Example

# The Age Calculator - Task: Want to find out how old you'll be? Calculate it!

- Add a paragraph element `<p id="age"></p>`
- Write a `<script>` to:
- Store the following into variables:
  - Declare a variable for your birth year, name it **birthYr**.
  - Assign your actual birth year in the variable, **birthYr**. For example,  
**birthYr = 1990;**
  - Declare a variable for a future year, name it **futureYr**.
  - Assign a future year in the variable, **futureYr**. For example,  
**futureYr = 2025;**

Output to your web page like so:

**document.getElementById("age").innerHTML = "I will be" + NN "in" + YYYY**
