INSTRUCTIONS: - Read the statements below and perform the tasks.

1. Create a HTML document, save as: **iftwonums.html**
2. Add a heading element **If 2 Integers Example.**
3. Create a **button** that when clicked will call the **twoNums()** function.
4. Add a paragraph element **<p id="bignum"></p>**.
5. Write a <script> to display the largest of two numbers. In your script,
 - a. Create a **function** called **twoNums()**.
 - i. In the function prompt the user for 2 integers. Use **num1** and **num2** as your variable.
 - ii. **REMINDER:** Input from the user will always be a STRING, use **parseInt** to convert each string to an integer.
6. Write an **if block** statement:
 - a. If the first number is greater than the second number, display in the **<p>** “bignum” element.
_____ “**is the bigger number**”;
 - b. or if the second number is greater than the second number, display
_____ “**is the bigger number**”;
 - c. otherwise, display “The numbers are equal” in a
