

INSTRUCTIONS: - Read the statements below and perform the tasks.

1. Create a HTML document, save as: **arraymethods.html**

2. Add a heading element **Array Methods**.

3. Add several paragraph element

`<p id="music1"></p>`

...

`<p id="music6"></p>`

4. Write a `<script>` to:

- a. Create a **styles** array with items **"Jazz"**, **"Blues"**, and **"Pop"**
styles = [fill the array with the styles of music (see above)]

5. For each of the following, display in a **document.getElementById**

- a. Display the entire **styles** [array] in the **"music1"** HTML element.
- b. Strip off the last value of the **styles** [array] then display the array in the **"music2"** HTML element.
- c. Append **"Rock-n-Roll"** to the end of the **styles** [array] then display the array in the **"music3"** HTML element.
- d. Strip off the first value of the **styles** [array] and then display the array in the **"music4"** HTML element.
- e. Add **"Reggae"** to the beginning to the **styles** [array] and then display the array in the **"music5"** element.
- f. Sort the **styles** [array] alphabetically and then display the array in the **"music6"** element.
