



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. [Open cssmagazine.html](#). Modify the file to create a magazine web page similar to the first page.
2. TITLE **<title>**: Use a descriptive page title.
3. CSS **<style>**. See the next page for **suggested** CSS. Make changes until you like the result.
4. **STEP 1: Heading and Body Background.**
 - For the magazine heading use **<h1>**.
 - Think of a better title for your magazine.
 - Be creative on your styling.
 - For the **<body>**
 - Choose an appealing background and font for the magazine.
5. **STEP 2: Divs for two Columns (see the file).**
 - Two **<div>**s and class attributes were used for the 2 columns so it can be styled.
 - Column1 has a class="column1", and Column2 has a class="column2".
 - Inside Column1 **<div>**, there are 2 more **<div>**s for:
 - **<h2>** heading
 - and **** ordered list
 - Inside Column2 **<div>**, there is a **<div>** for:
 - a **<h2>** heading
 - and the **** kitten picture
6. **STEP 3: Column 2 – Heading and Kitten Picture (see the file).**
 - Inside the **<div class="column2">**, add the kitten.jpg **** tag.
 - A class="photo" was used so it can be styled.
 - Make changes until you like the result.
 - Add another **<div class="item">** around the **** and add a **<h2>** heading.
7. **STEP 4: Column 1 – Heading and Ordered List (see the file).**
 - Add **<h2>** heading and the **** Ordered List.
 - Add another **<div>** with content in the box below the ordered list.
 - Make changes until you like the result.
