

In- Class Exercise – JS Output (innerHTML)

INSTRUCTIONS: - Read the statements below and perform the tasks.

1. Open your template.html document, Save As: **jsexercise1.html**
2. Add a header element (use the largest size) with the following content **Welcome to CS211**. Give your header element an id "**mhead**"
3. Add a paragraph element with the following content **This is a p element**. Give your p element an id "**mpara**"
4. Add a div element with the following content **This is a div element**. Give your div element an id "**mdiv**"
5. Use a **<button>** tag for each of the following:
 - a. Find an HTML element (with **id="mhead"**) and change the element content (**innerHTML**) to "**Welcome to JavaScript**".
 - b. Find an HTML element (with **id="mpara"**) and change the element content (**innerHTML**) to "**JavaScript Introduction**".
 - c. Find an HTML element (with **id="mdiv"**) and change the element content (**innerHTML**) to "**How To?**".

Example:

<button type="button" onclick="document.getElementById("give it an id").innerHTML = "Enter Text to Change Here"">Click Me!</button>
