What is a Function?

- A set of code that you use to repeat a task.

Function Tasks

- DEFINE the function.
- CALL the function.
- Code inside the function are executed.

You have already used Python **Built-in** Functions!

- `print()`
- `input()`
- `len()`
- `str()`
- `int()`
- `float()`

FUNCTION SYNTAX:

```
def function_name( ):  
    indented block of code  
    code  
    code
```

#**descriptive** function name
#end line with **colon**

How do you **call a function**? –use its name

```
def sayhi():          #define function  
    print("Hello User")  
  
sayhi()             #calls the function
```



How do you **call** a function? –use its name

```
def sayhi():  
    print("Hello User")  
  
print("Top")  
sayhi()  
print("Bottom")
```

#define function
#prints “Top”
#calls the function
#print “Bottom”
