**MEMORANDUM
OF
UNDERSTANDING AND AGREEMENT
(Articulation of UOG and GCC Courses)**

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AND AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the University of Guam, hereinafter referred to as the UOG, and the Guam Community College, hereinafter referred to as GCC.

WITNESSETH THAT

WHEREAS, the mission of the UOG is to provide higher education programs for the people of Guam and the Western Pacific Island communities;

WHEREAS, the UOG is accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Senior Colleges and Universities, Western Association of Schools and Colleges;

WHEREAS, GCC is accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges;

WHEREAS, the UOG and GCC recognize the mutual benefits of the academic articulation and transfer of course credits between UOG and GCC;

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions stated below, the UOG and GCC agree as follows:

1. That the UOG and GCC will accept the transfer of credits as listed below as equivalent or comparable as per current UOG Undergraduate Catalog year 2007-2008 and GCC catalogs at time of admission;
