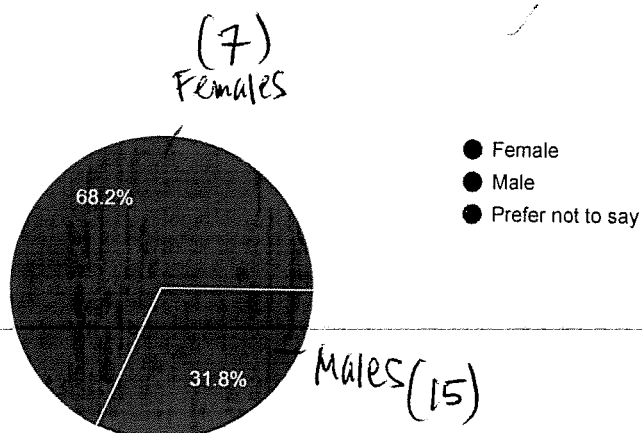

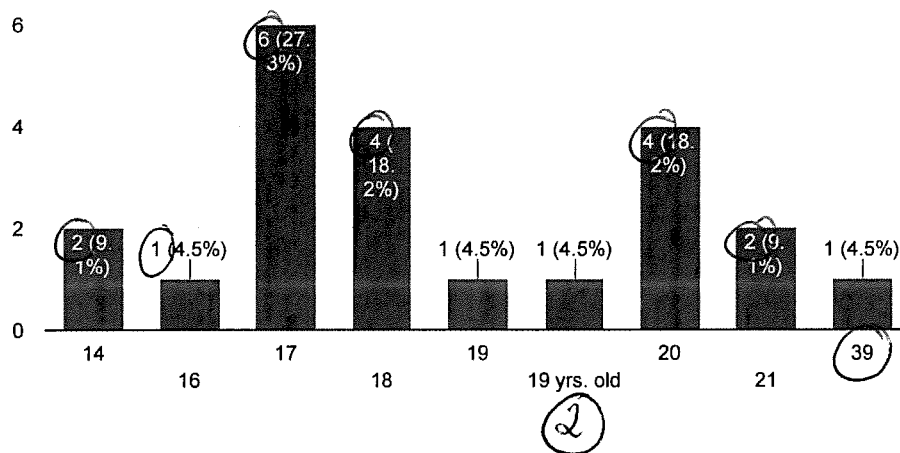

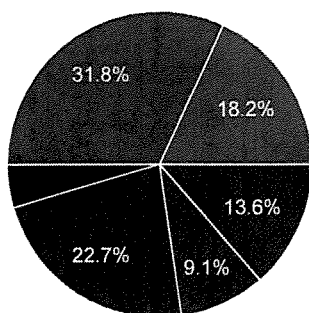

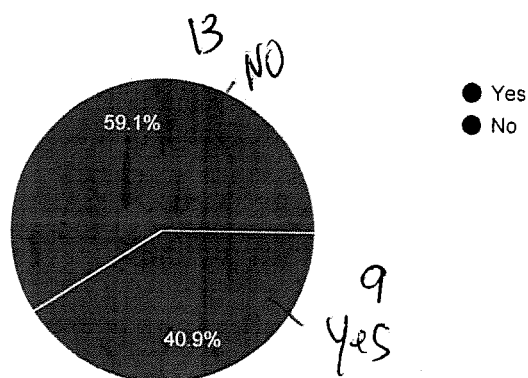

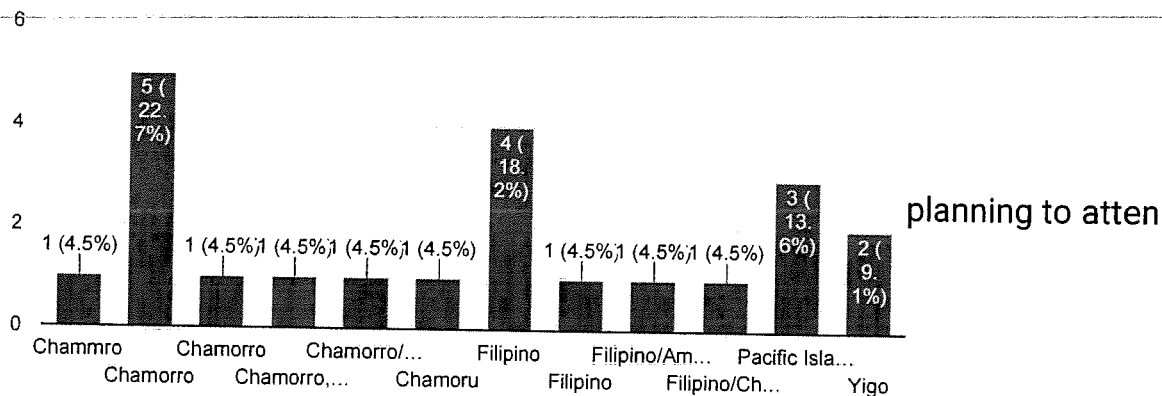

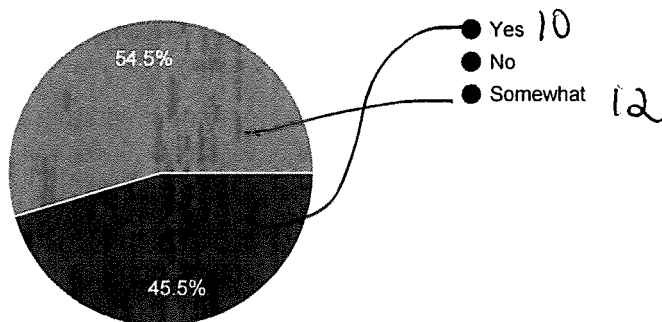

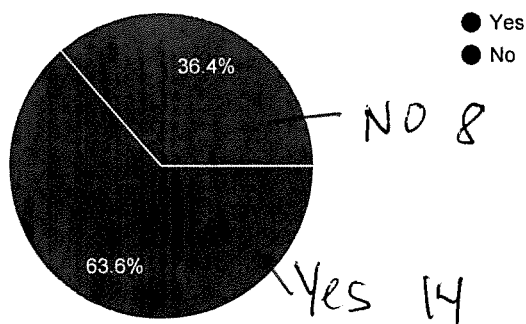

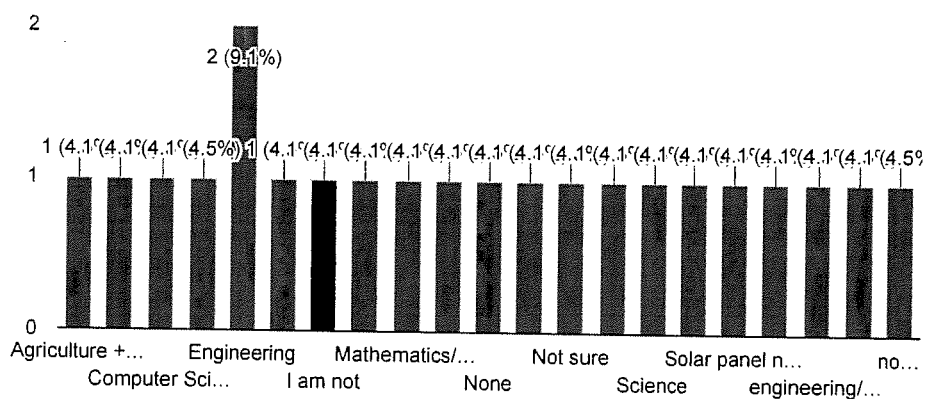

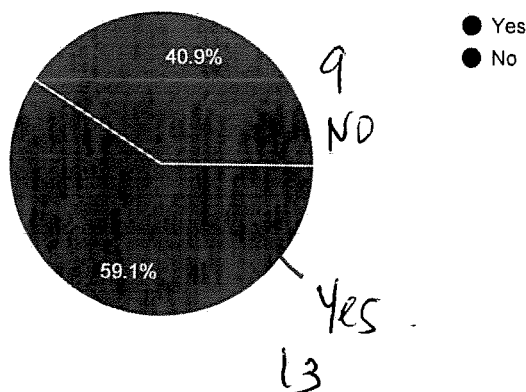
6) Did the STEEP encourage you to enter a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering)

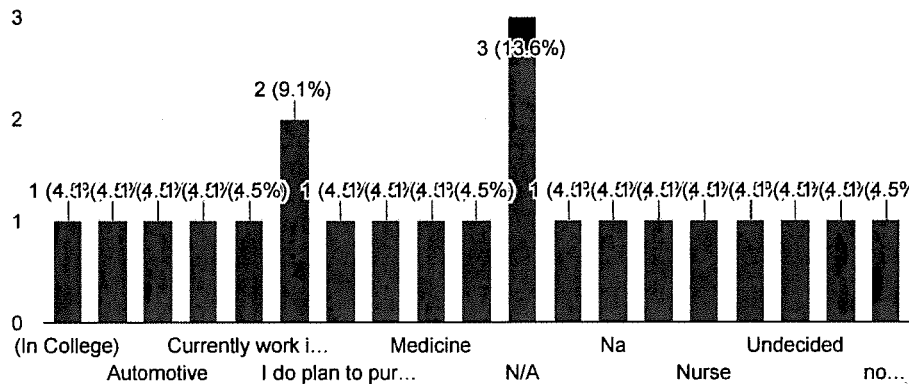
7) If you are still in high school (secondary-level school) do you plan on pursuing

8) If not, what career path are you planning to pursue?

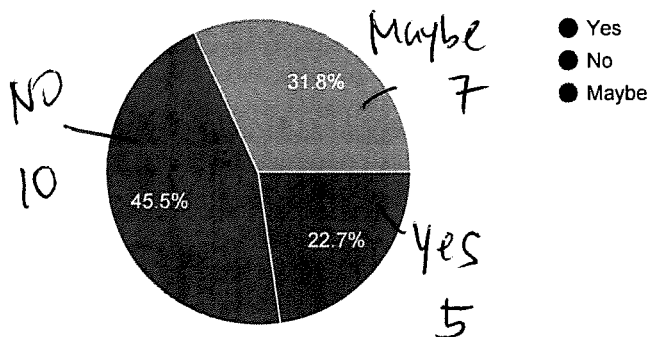

has taught me to be innovative and to expand my mind to fill it with knowledge that will help me in the future years to come.

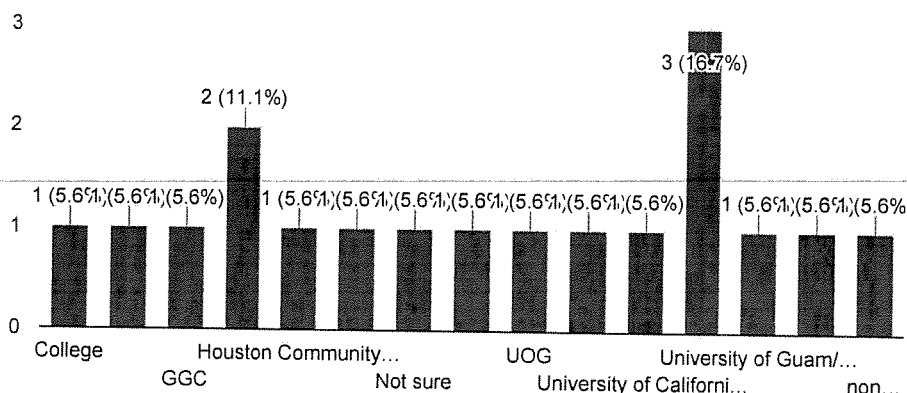
Steep
