THS Program Assessment Narrative

FA2022-SP2023 Upon completion of the course, students will be able to demonstrate workplace soft skills in various culinary and foodservice settings.

Description: Experiential Learning. Students will participate in a minimum of one experiential learning activity that will demonstrate workplace soft skills. For Tiyan High School (THS), Hyatt Regency Guam and the THS Spring Dance Competition Event was the training site used to apply workplace soft skills. Students were given opportunities to work both in the front of the house and back of the house between Summer 2022- Spring 2023. The Work Experience Program rating sheet assessment rubric based on a 5-0 grading scale.

Summary of Results

Data were collected from various WE activities with cohorts that started in FA2020 and FA2021. Total number of students that started in the cohort was 34. 17 students are expected to complete the program in SP2023. Out of 34 students, 3 students have completed a minimum of 180 hours of WE and upon graduation will receive the Certificate of Mastery. 2 out of 17 students are currently working in the culinary industry. Out of 34 students, 30 students participated in the THS Spring Dance Competition, where students were able to demonstrate catering as a schoolwide performance-based learning (PBL). The work experience evaluation rating sheet was provided by the employer and instructor and used to measure students in workplace soft skills in various culinary and foodservice settings. Number of examinees was N=34. Out of 34, 34 students scored 85% and up in the Work Experience and THS Spring Dance Competition event. Number of students who failed was 0.

Students are to score a minimum of 70% in the Work Experience and THS Spring Dance Competition Event.
