CONTACTS

- 1** Take your official High School transcripts to Student Services & Admin (Bldg. 2000). Get and fill out your registration packet.
- 2** Bring recent shot records and valid ID to the Health Service Center (Bldg 5000).
- 3** Visit the Financial Aid Office (Bldg 2000) and apply for FAFSA (Free Application For Student Aid), if you are qualified.
- 4** Seek for academic advisement. For non-declared students, talk to a counselor (Bldg 2000). For declared students, seek for your advisor.
- 5** Sign up for your classes. Sign up online at mygcc.guamcc.edu or in Bldg 2000.
- 6** Obtain your GCC ID at Student Support Services.
- 7** On the first day of classes, learn what books you need and purchase them at the bookstore (Bldg F).


