

## JavaScript Programming Test

### 1. T-shirt Shop

Write a program that asks the user how many t-shirts they would like to buy, and then prints out the total cost.

You should declare a constant at the top of your program called `COST_OF_SHIRT` and set it equal to 20.

A sample output might look like:

How many tshirts? 4 Your total cost is \$80 dollars.

### 2. Running Speed

Write a program that asks the user how far they ran (in miles) and then how long it took them (in minutes), and print out their speed in miles per hour.

In order to pass the autograder, your program must first ask how far the user ran, and then how long it took them.

A sample run of the program might look like this:

How many miles did you run? 8 How many minutes did it take you? 120 Speed in mph: 4
