the recommendation for the labs with iMac devices since the Apple products that are part of GCC-FB-21-002 are no longer available.

While the industry best practice is to replace computers every two to five years, TWG will formally establish the computer replacement cycle policy at its upcoming meeting on Wednesday, November 10, 2021 to ensure that all of the College's computers are on covered under the replacement cycle on a going forward basis.
