2. SLO development for GCC Gen Ed courses

A major clarification on the role of the Gen Ed committee was provided to the Committee's liaison to AIE, Frank Camacho, by Dr. Ray Somera. According to Dr. Somera, the Gen Ed Committee would be responsible for determining which SLO's were being addressed within each of the approximately 470 courses offered at GCC. In addition, assessment tools for each SLO would be developed that cut across the different courses in order to facilitate assessment using a single instrument per SLO. The Gen Ed Committee heard these points of clarification with great interest and expressed several specific concerns regarding the Committee's new role. In particular, the question of assessing courses that were likely to occur early in a student's program, before they have completed the GE requirements for their degree, was a major concern. Additionally, the motivation for assessing Gen Ed SLO's across the curriculum was called into question. To address this, Tico Tenorio suggested inviting Dr. Somera

to attend the next Gen Ed Committee meeting. Until then, it was agreed that the issue would be tabled until further clarification could be provided by AIE.
