Represent GCC on the Youth Congress

The Youth Congress acts as legislative body comprised of members between the ages of 14 and 25, representing Guam's villages, middle schools, high schools, UOG and the Guam Community College.

The Youth Congress has the power to make its own rules, establish committees, hold hearings, pass resolutions and prepare and pass bills, which will be forwarded to the Rules Committee of the Guam Legislature for action as with a legislative bill.

The Youth Congress will represent the youth of Guam, their desires and aspirations, and will serve as a training and action area for Guam's future leaders.

GCC is allotted three (3) representatives.



GCC Representation Requirements:

- 1. Deadline to apply: by 2pm, Tuesday, October 14, 2014, at the CSI office
- 2. Shall be an officially registered GCC postsecondary student
- 3. Shall serve a TWO-YEAR term from October 2014 through October 2016
- 4. Shall meet once a month in session (compensated \$25 for each regular or special session attended)
- 5. Shall not be over the age of 25 BEFORE the end of your term
