SUBJECT: Distance Education (DE) pilot courses for Fall 2015

DATE: February 19, 2015

One of the major recommendations made in our team evaluation report from ACCJC was to develop a Strategic Plan for Distance Education (DE). The Distance Education Committee comprising of faculty and administrators have begun taking the steps towards GCC being able to offer its students the option of distance learning since about a year ago.

The procurement of a third party Moodle vendor has been finalized and administrators and faculty will soon be undergoing training. In light of this progress, GCC will be launching three DE pilot courses for Fall 2015. The courses to be offered are:

- 1) OA101 Keyboarding and Document Processing (two sections will be offered: one section will be fully online and the other section will be hybrid)
- 2) MA110 Finite Mathematics
- 3) EN110 Freshman Composition

With the launch of the three DE pilot courses, no other online courses will be offered for Fall 2015.
